Idaho Meth Project Staff and Former Meth Addict to Speak to Rigby Lions Club *Event Open to the Public*

RIGBY, Idaho — April 2, 2014 — On Thursday, April 24, Cyn Reneau of the Idaho Meth Project will present to members of the Rigby Lions Club at the Rigby Senior Center. Cyn is the Director of Education and Development for the Idaho Meth Project and is also a recovering Meth addict. A former member of law enforcement and mother of two, Cyn will explain the facts about Meth and share her personal story of how her addiction devastated her life and the lives of her loved ones.

Open to the public, the presentation will include information on Meth's short- and long-term effects, how Meth abuse affects individuals, families and businesses, and how to initiate conversations with teens regarding drug use.

This presentation is part of the Idaho Meth Project's statewide community outreach and public education program promoting the "Meth: Not Even Once" message. The Idaho Meth Project, a nonprofit organization, visits over 200 Idaho schools and community groups annually in an effort to raise awareness about the devastating effects of Meth and prevent Meth use.
